


MARKET SHARE OF PURCHASE TRANSACTIONS WORLDWIDE DATA



TERMS TO KNOW

Issuer

The financial institution that issued the customer's card and is responsible for paying the acquirer.

Network

The lines through which information is passed to allow for the settlement of a transaction.

Processor

Mediator between the issuer and acquirer for settlement of a transaction.

Acquirer

The merchant's financial institution. Card Present (CP)

A transaction in which the card is physically present as when a

customer swipes, dips or taps their card in a store.

example, online or phone transactions are CNP.

Card Not Present (CNP) A transaction in which the card is not physically present. For
